

PLASMA DONOR
CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) SAFE PASSAGE LETTER
TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

As a plasma donor who has donated plasma with CSL Plasma Inc. (“CSL”) or intends to donate plasma at CSL, one of the world’s largest collectors of human plasma, you help provide the critical ingredient in the manufacture of plasma-derived medicines used to treat patients suffering from a host of life-threatening conditions and bleeding disorders.

The United States Department of Homeland Security March 19, 2020 Memorandum on Identification of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers during COVID-19 Response makes clear that “plasma donors and employees of the organizations that operate and manage related activities” are part of the essential critical infrastructure workforce. Because you are a plasma donor, CSL is providing you with this letter for you to present to law enforcement personnel or other authorities as necessary to confirm the importance of your need to travel to and from your residence to donate plasma—whether with CSL Plasma or another plasma collector—in the event that a stay-in-place or similar order is issued by a federal, state or local government.
